OTHER INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BY THE STATE COUNCIL:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister has concluded the Meeting with the following instructions on the implementation of Scheduled Castes Component schemes by various Departments.

1. The Hon'ble Chief Minister and Chairperson of the Council stated that the grounding of the Dr.B.R.AmbedkarSmruthiVanam along with the 125 feet statue of Dr.B.R.Ambedkar shall be taken up on priority and it shall be completed for inauguration on April 14, 2021. Social Welfare Department in coordination with APIIC shall ensure that the work is of best standards in terms

of landscaping that provides beautiful ambience and lung space for the visitors and walkers and it should be an icon for the city of Vijayawada. It is to be ensured that concrete structures shall be the bare minimum in the project.

2. The Hon'ble Chief Minister has stated that a committee be constituted with Ministers (with Minister for Social Welfare, Minister for Education, Minister for Women Development & Child Welfare & Minister for MA & UD) and requested to review and suggest the measures for the completion of the project and a committee of Secretary/ Principal Secretary / Special Chief Secretary (I & C, Finance, Social Welfare, Tribal Welfare & Planning & Director of Social Welfare) to be constituted and requested to finalize, approve, review the site development and salient features or components as proposed under the project.
3. The Hon'ble Minister also stated that YSR Asara and YSR Cheyutha are the new schemes to be focussed upon during 2020-21 as they would help the weaker section women of SGHs to use the financial assistance being given by the Government in next four years as equity (20%) and tie up with banks for additional loans (80%) to enhance their production, market their products and gain additional income to their families. Government is also tying up with agencies like AMUL, H.L.L and ITC to extend this marketing support to the SC, ST women beneficiaries of self-help groups.
4. Sri Dharmana Krishna Das, Hon'ble Minister for Roads and Buildings, requested that a small tribe by name ' YanetiKhond' resides in Srikakulam district, but they are not recognised as Scheduled Tribes by the Government, thereby depriving them of the statutory benefits that they are eligible for. Hon'ble Chief Minister and Chairperson of the State Council requested that their grievance be referred to a committee, to be constituted by the Tribal Welfare Department for a detailed study and recommend to the Government the steps to be taken the redress the problems.

The Secretary to the Government Social Welfare Department concluded the meeting with vote of thanks to the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Hon'ble Ministers and Secretaries and HODs.

The proposal is pending for sanction at Government Level as the Finance Department requested all the Departments of Secretariat and Head of the Departments to defer all such proposals for creation of new posts, up gradation and re-designation of posts

and confirming Gazetted status to any category till issue of orders on the recommendation of the 11th Pay Revision Commission vide Circular Memo No.Fin.01-62021/21/2018-PC and TA, dt.28.02.2018.

It is required to position the Administrative Unit with the above (14) Posts on par with Social Welfare Department as early as possible for effective implementation of STC (earlier TSP).

For taking up activities such as analysis of all the schemes taken up under Schedule Tribe Component (STC) by the Line Departments, preparation of Annual Reports and work plans the Technical and Monitoring Support Unit services are required to the STC and permit the department to take up the services of reputed agency on outsourcing basis.

Resolution: Permitted the department to hire the services from the reputed agency on outsourcing basis for establishment of Technical& Monitoring Support unit as per norms.

Delegation of the power to the Nodal Agencies to approve the Annual Scheduled Castes Sub Plan/ Tribal Sub Plan proposals of the Departments and any new schemes/ works proposed by the departments during the year, subject to ratification by the State Council:

It is proposed that the State Council may delegate the authority to the Nodal Agency for giving approval of the action plans and new schemes / works, subject to ratification in the subsequent meeting of the State Council.

Resolution: The State Council for development of SCs & STs has agreed the proposal and delegated powers to the Nodal agencies to approve the Annual proposals of the departments and new schemes/works proposed by the departments subject to ratification by the State Council.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BY THE STATE COUNCIL:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister has concluded the Meeting with the following instructions on the implementation of Scheduled Tribes Component schemes by various Departments:

The Hon'ble Minister also stated that YSR Asara and YSR Cheyutha are the new schemes to be focussed upon during 2020-21 as they would help the weaker section women of SGHs to use the financial assistance being given by the Government in next four years as equity (20%) and tie up with banks for additional loans (80%) to enhance their production, market their products and gain additional income to their families. Government is also tying up with agencies like AMUL, H.L.L and ITC to extend this marketing support to the SC, ST women beneficiaries of self-help groups.

Sri Dharmana Krishna Das, Hon'ble Minister for Roads and Buildings, requested that a small tribe by name 'YanetiKhond' resides in Srikakulam district, but they are not recognised as Scheduled Tribes by the Government, thereby depriving them of the statutory benefits that they are eligible for. Hon'ble Chief Minister and Chairperson of the State Council requested that their grievance be referred to a committee, to be constituted by the Tribal Welfare Department for a detailed study and recommend to the Government the steps to be taken the redress the problems.

The Secretary to the Government Tribal Welfare Department concluded the meeting with vote of thanks to the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Hon'ble Ministers and Secretaries and HODs.
